

Tibi, Chuti, Thutma

Material: Silk, cotton, threads and wool.

Description: This headdress is worn by the people to represent long hair. It is made up of three parts. The hat is called '*Tibi*', the hair is called '*Chuti*' and '*Thutma*' (made of thread) is used to tie the hair.

Use: These are worn during local traditional dances.

Used by: Both the men and women of the Leh district, Jammu & Kashmir, India, in the Western Himalayas.
